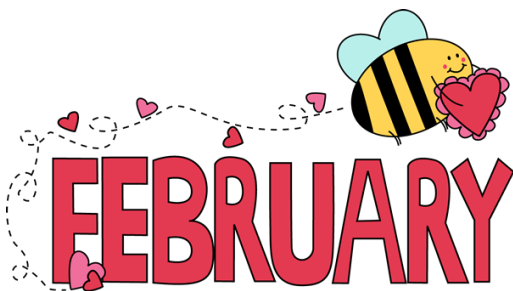
Sweetheart Fundraiser

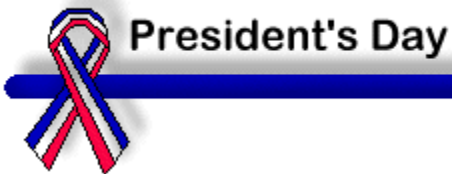
They are \$1.00 each, cash only please.
